

Mid-Atlantic Association Quarterly Meeting
December 15, 2010

A. Monique White called the meeting to order at 7:35 P.M.

Secretary's Report: Ken noted he had copies of the minutes for the Association Annual Meeting and the November 17, 2010 Executive Committee meeting minutes available. He also noted the Officers & Directors liability insurance was in place for the year.

Treasurer's Report: Norman Green reviewed his report dated December 13, 2010 which reported a net worth of \$121,925.14.

Financial Secretary's Report: Mary reviewed her report dated November 17, 2010. Upon discussion it was accepted.

President's Report: Monique noted the Association had three Level 1 coaching schools in place for 2011. She also commented that the Annual meeting was productive.

Vice-President & L&L Reports: Mike Hemsley reported that he attended the Association Committee meetings at the Annual Meeting and noted there were no significant changes that would impact Mid-Atlantic.

High Performance Committee Report: Monique reviewed the report submitted by Ray Feick listing the anticipated dates for 2011 competitions.

LDR Report: Monique reviewed the report submitted by Robin Jefferis.

YA Report: No report was submitted but Monique mentioned Celeste has been mandated to hold the Junior Olympic Championship on June 25th and that a site has not yet been confirmed.

Law & Legislation Committee Report: Mike had nothing further to report.

Membership Report: No report was submitted but Doreen McCoubrie had previously reported we have 505 members and 28 clubs for 2011.

Budget and Finance Committee Report: Bob DeLambily distributed the proposed budget for 2011. Upon discussion it was accepted.

Officials Report: Ken noted that a successful clinic was again held at Penn State with 20 in attendance and the potential for 15 new officials. He again reported that the Mid-Atlantic Officials Committee Annual Meeting was scheduled for March 20th at the Fort Washington Holiday Inn. The presenters will be Len & Karen Krsak, speaking on throws and clerking.

Communications Committee Report: Norm Green expressed disappointment that the newsletter did not get distributed on time. A general discussion was held primarily noting the newsletter has not yet been posted on the website as repeatedly requested by Paul Spencer.

Awards Committee: Norm discussed the possible need to move our Awards Luncheon due to new management of the facility we have used for the last 20 years.

Old Business: Norm Green noted our website is less functional that it had been prior to making changes required by the National office and that the webmaster has not been responsive. Mike Hemsley was requested to send a letter to the webmaster expressing our concerns.

New Business: Monique reported that Bob DeLambily was awarded the New Jersey High School (boys) Official of the Year and Bob was congratulated.

Kyle Mecklenborg reported that he and Cardwell Wooten were preparing a proposal to create a track & field grand prix and will be submitting the proposal to the High Performance committee for possible roll-out in 2012.

It was noted that one of our members, Solomiya Login, was elected to the national AAC committee for race walk.

Upon motion and seconding the proposed 2011 budget was adopted.

It was announced a special Executive Committee meeting would be held immediately upon completion of the quarterly meeting.
